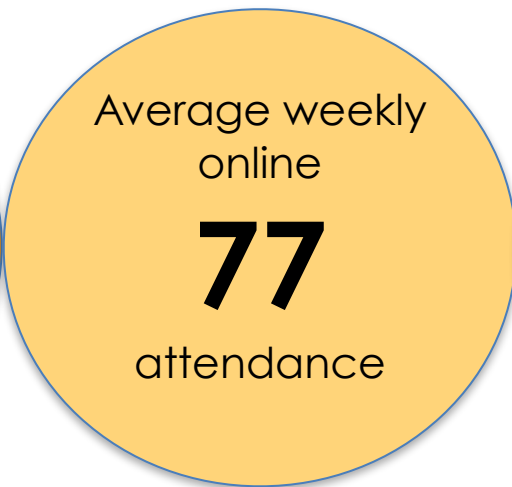
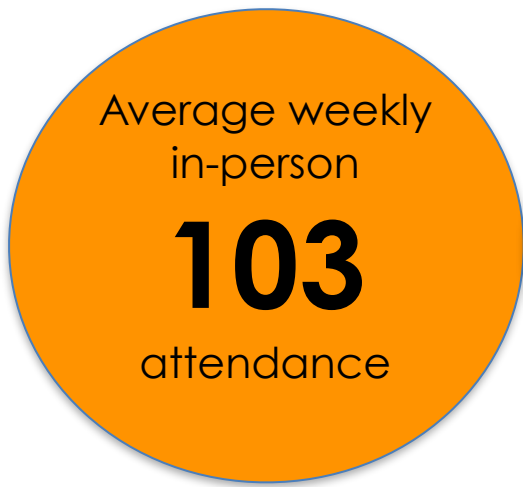

What did **198** Christ followers do in 2022?

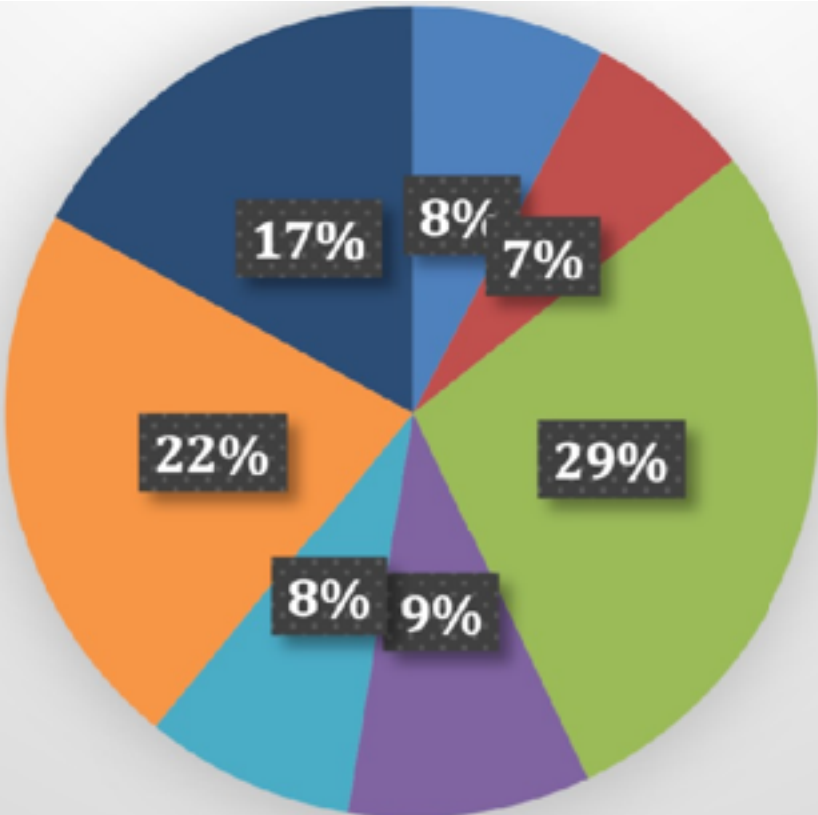
Christ Lutheran was recognized by the larger community as the non-profit of the year with the **Spirit of Sedona** award for our incredible community impact.

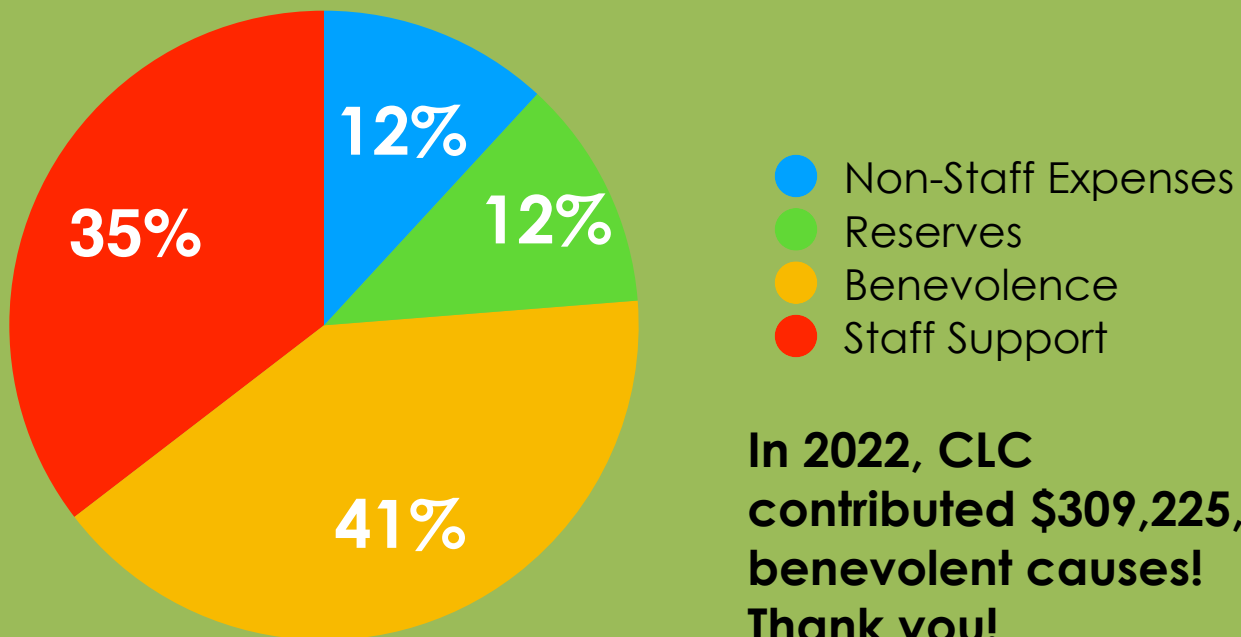
